The latest example of our commitment to investing in state -of-the-art technology is a 20 position simulator with 2K x 2K raster scan colour displays.

Costing over £2.8 million, it allows us to





run a variety of courses at the same time and brings the number of simulators at the College up to four. We are also upgrading our aerodrome simulators.

Our new £2.5 million training block is equally sophisticated. It has 10 air conditioned classrooms with the latest video equipment and other advanced teaching aids. Two of these also have

response monitoring systems, enabling us to question students electronically and monitor their performances.

Strong financial resources mean that we will be able to continue to invest in the most advanced technology and facilities and provide the quality of support that has become the hallmark of our college.

Ratings

We provide the full range of rating courses for UK and ICAO qualifications, including area, approach and aerodrome control training. Students are taught in English - the international language of civil aviation - and given the personal attention needed to develop their individual skills. All of our courses on simulators, for example, are on a one-to-one basis. To personalise our courses even further, we can programme our simulators to recreate your local air traffic system. If necessary, we can provide the training on your premises.



Specialist courses

Training is a skill that has to be taught. These courses will help your trainers develop the necessary technical and interpersonal skills.

On-the-job training: starts with a distance learning package using videos and booklets to explain the main principles behind training and how to develop relationships with students to harness their potential. This is then followed by an intensive one-week practical course involving roleplaying and other techniques in a controlled environment.


